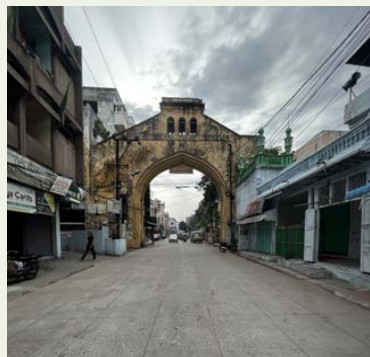

The Gateways or historic Kamaans leading to significant areas are found throughout the city of Hyderabad, which was founded in 1591 AD, during the reign of Qutb Shah V, Mohammad Quli Qutb Shah. The central axis towards Charminar was marked by the Char Kamaan, which originally served as gateways to the Royal Palaces and Office Complexes.

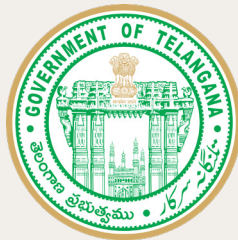
Various other Kamaans in the city served as monumental entry gateways to important palace complexes, bustling markets, prominent streets, and religious spaces.
