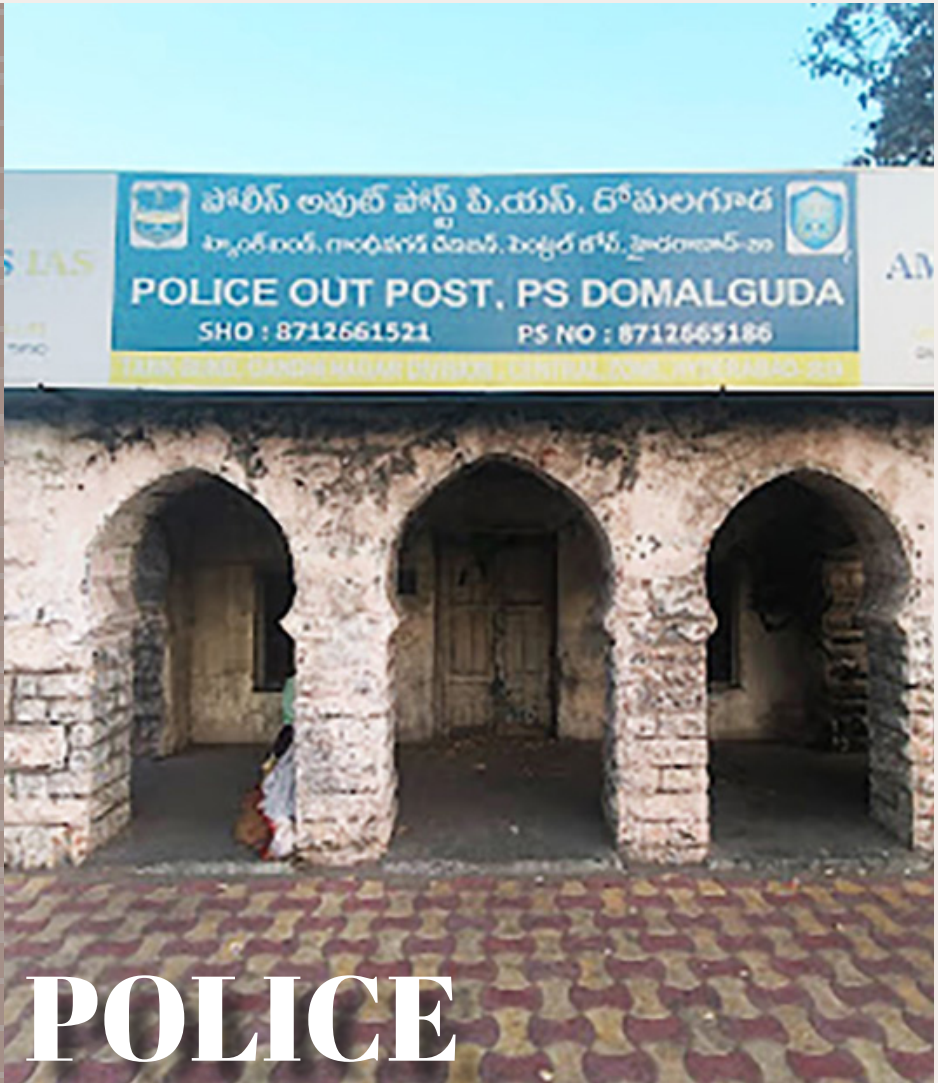




POLICE OUTPOST TANK BUND

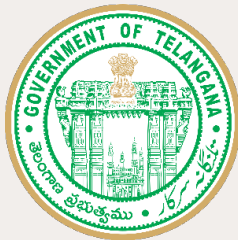
HERITAGE PARTNER SCHEME

During the Nizam era, a large network of Police Outposts was set up throughout Hyderabad for monitoring and posts for patrol officers, especially at major centres of the city and the outskirts. One of the significant Outposts is located at Hussain Sagar and would have catered to officers patrolling the entire area of Hussain Sagar, military areas and what is now known as Lower Tank Bund.

The Outpost has an exceptional view of the water body and its surroundings, but it has been unused and in need of maintenance.
